The NILES CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT will hold a H1N1 vaccine clinic at the Mayor Ralph Infante Wellness Center located at 213 Sharkey Drive in Waddell Park, Niles, Ohio on November 17, 2009 from 9:00am thru 2:00pm. This clinic is provided to the Initial Target Group of individuals at this time.

Initial Target Groups: Vaccine will be administered to persons in the following five target groups (order of target groups does not indicate priority):

- pregnant women,
- persons who live with or provide care for infants aged <6 months (e.g., parents, siblings, and daycare providers),
- health-care and emergency medical services personnel,
- persons aged 6 months--24 years, and
- persons aged 25--64 years who have medical conditions that put them at higher risk for influenza-related complications

Those planning to get vaccinated are encouraged to register for the vaccine on line at <https://h1n1vaccine.odh.ohio.gov> or by visiting the <http://nilesh1n1.com> website for pre-registration information.

Please bring the printed consent form with you at the time of vaccination. Persons will also be able to fill out consent forms at the H1N1 flu clinic. Pregnant women must also have a note from their OBGYN Doctor to receive the vaccination.
